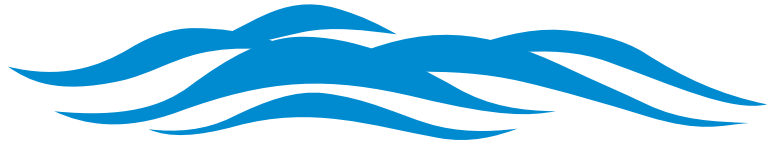

Pool Lifeguard Challenge 2021



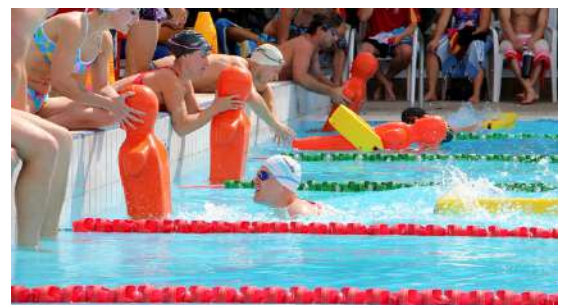
LIWA Aquatics is proud to be supporting and sponsoring the 2021 Pool Lifeguard Challenge again this year.

Perth Metro, Peel and South West go into 5 day Lockdown

News was brought on quickly and the response was swift. As of 6pm Sunday 31st January Perth Metro, Peel and South West Regions of WA are now in Lockdown.



**Lockdown:

We have had numerous calls in relation to pool water testing and have sought advice from the Department of Health WA in relation to this. Please see the information below.

If your employer (mainly local government has considered your work as essential and you are not able to work from home (ie a Pool Manager) then you may attend work (under the advice or your employer). You **MUST** wear a face mask at all times at your workplace. It is also advisable to obtain written permission to state that you are attending work as a local government employee if asked at Police checks.

Department of Health WA

Question: Is performing daily water tests (1 test per day) sufficient whilst pools are closed during lockdown to ensure chemistry & water clarity is maintained and pool plant is still operational.

Answer: **YES**

Question: If a pool manager is onsite daily (do they have to continue with 4 hourly tests (whilst facility is closed)?

Answer: **NO**

Question: If a person is NOT able to attend onsite to test the water during the 5 day closure, will the Department of Health require a water sample for testing prior to opening?

Answer: **NO** - Providing water chemistry has been maintained and the results are duly logged. (This position may need to be reviewed if the closure period is extended)

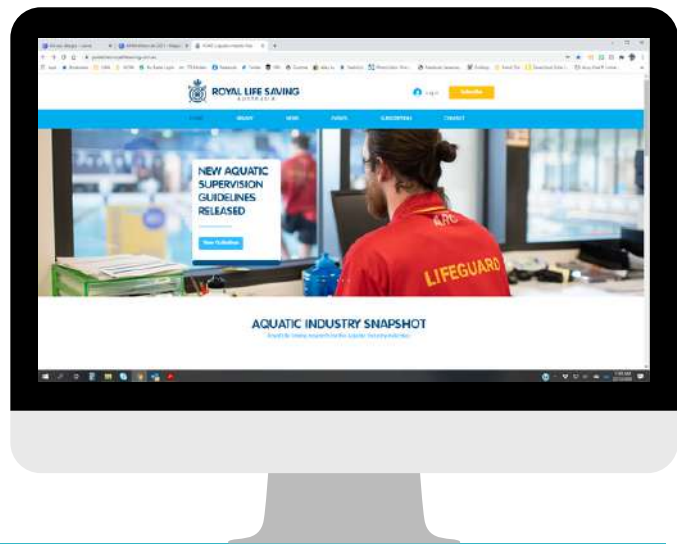
LIWA to fund Aquatic Industry Safety Hub Subscription for regional facilities

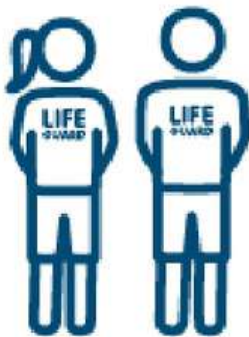
